The University of Göttingen is headquartered in the centre of the city of Göttingen at Wilhelmsplatz 1. The University has two major campuses, the central campus and the north campus; but many of the University's faculties and institutes are spread all over the city, making Göttingen a "univer-city".

2.1 What kind of services do you offer to international students and, in particular, for KOSPIE students?

The KOSPIE students at the University of Göttingen have a supervisor who supports them on a personal basis for the length of their stay. In addition, the KOSPIE students benefit from a wide array of services and facilities. Just to name a few:

Welcome and introductory events bringing international students together,





language courses - free of charge,

the International Foyer, a meeting place for all students offering weekly extensive cultural activities and excursions,

the Accommodation Service, which aids international students in finding affordable housing, Career Services, supporting students to find internships and prepare for the job market, the University's sport center offering a wide selection of sports activities, a large network of student cafeterias,

and of course, the academic services of the University, including the Göttingen State and University Library with its current holdings of about 9 million media units, which ranks among the largest libraries in Germany

2.2 What are the most special attractions for international students in the region? (up to 250 words)

Göttingen with a population of approx. 130,000 is a city where tradition and innovation complement one another perfectly. The city dates back to the Middle Ages and still boasts a unique historic centre with beautiful half-timbered buildings giving the city centre a fairy-tale atmosphere.

While the architecture breathes history, the spirit of Göttingen is young, vibrant, and international thanks to its more than 30,000 students, which make Göttingen a student city, safe, fun, and lively. Göttingen is located in the centre of Germany and has excellent train connections to major cities in Germany like Berlin, Hamburg and Munich. Göttingen offers many cultural and sports activities, as well as plenty of cafés and bars. The University's sport facilities offer the possibility to practice a wide variety of sports and is open for all students of the University. The city hosts many festivals and annual events, which include the Nacht der Kultur, the Jazz Festival, the International Literature Festival and the European Film Festival. The University hosts year round activities such as conferences, film festivals, concerts, and exhibitions. The surroundings of Göttingen are ideal for hiking, mountain biking, or just relaxing in nature.
