







# **UNAM call for Applications for INTERNATIONAL STUDENT MOBILITY** FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS



Spring 2026



In order to strengthen our academic collaboration and increase student mobility among our International Higher Education Institutions, Universidad Nacional Autónoma de México (UNAM), through our Office for International Cooperation "DGECI" (Dirección General de Cooperación e Internacionalización),

#### **INVITES**

Higher Education Institutions (HEI) to apply students for undergraduate mobility for the following types of mobility: degree subjects, research stays or professional experience at UNAM, during the period of Spring 2026 (February - June 2026) in accordance with the following:

#### I. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

Participating students should do the following:

- 1. Obtain a Nomination Letter from their home HEI.
- 2. Submit Proof of current course enrollment, in english or french, from current degree studies (prior to the exchange).
- 3. Submit Official academic transcript, in english or french, including the general GPA (minimum 8/10 or its equivalent on UNAM's scale) and proof of completion of at least 40% of the total program credits or the percentage required by the interested UNAM's Schools, if higher. If the student does not meet the GPA or credit percentage, the application may still be submitted but will be subject to the School evaluation.
- 4. Comply with the requirements for the type of stay being applied for (undergraduate degree subjects, research stays or professional experience), as described in this call.
- **5.** Comply with the **Specific requirements** from UNAM's School accordingly.
- **6.** Fill in and sign the **Commitment Letter**. Find the specific format at using the format available at: https://cutt.ly/OrJEeXSh
- 7. Submit a Passport valid for at least 6 months beyond the end of the stay.
- 8. For HEI in non-Spanish-speaking countries, submit a valid Official Spanish Language Certificate: DELE, SIELE Global (4 skills), SIELE S5 (2 skills), or a Certificate of Spanish Language Proficiency issued by the home HEI's language center, dated within the last 6 months, with a minimum level of B2, according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. - 9. Be nominated and submit the required documents according to Section IV. Procedure and Selection.

## II. REQUIREMENTS ACCORDING TO TYPE OF MOBILITY:

## 1. Undergraduate degree courses:

a. Fill in the subjects authorized by your university (at least 3). Students may choose subjects from a maximum of two UNAM's Schools. Courses are taught in Spanish, a few are available in english <a href="https://cutt.ly/prJEueYc">https://cutt.ly/prJEueYc</a>.

IMPORTANT: For annual mobility (Spring 2026 - Fall 2026), subjects must be selected for both terms.

## 2. Research stay:

- a. Submit an invitation letter from an UNAM's tutor, stating the start and end dates of the stay.
- **b.** Submit a research proposal or project approved by an UNAM's tutor (maximum 4 pages).
- 3. Professional experience: (Faculty of Medicine Clinical rotations; Faculty of Veterinary Medicine- Academic practices; Faculty of Accounting and Administration and Faculty of Higher Studies Zaragoza- Professional internships).
  - a. Submit a letter of motivation.

For activities in the Faculty of Medicine, students must first contact the Mobility Coordinator for prior approval to apply under this call.

#### IV. PROCEDURE AND SELECTION PROCESS:

- 1. Applications must be submitted through the Incoming Student Mobility Management System (SGMEE):
  - https://bit.ly/sgmeeunam
- 2. The home HEI will initiate the nomination, and the student will complete the registration and application, according to the instructions available https://cutt.ly/ArJFOVUr
- 3. Applications will be reviewed and evaluated by the corresponding UNAM's Schools.

Only those applications fulfilling all the requirements and documents requested at the call for applications will be considered.

The acceptance of applications that meet the requirements will be subject to the evaluation of the Schools.
